#### Airport Pick-up Service

- ▶ For exchange students arriving in Gangneung on a predetermined date, we offer a free airport pick-up service.
- ▶ In order to arrange a pick-up date, students must first contact GWNU's exchange program coordinator. Once an exchange student has purchased a flight ticket, he or she must inform the exchange coordinator immediately.
- ▶ It is not possible for the pick-up team to wait for students who do not arrive at the designated place on time. If you miss the designated pick-up time, it is recommended that you use public transportation to reach Gangneung and check into a dormitory.
